Directions to the Eastburn's are:

From East/West exit Interstate 10 (I-10) at 67th Avenue, proceed south off the freeway about 1/2mile to turn left (east) on Fillmore Street (if you make it to Van Buren, you've gone too far). Proceed down Fillmore Street toward 63rd Ave. The home is the 3rd house west of 63rd Ave on the right side of the road.

From the South (Loop 202 South Mountain) exit Loop 202 at Van Buren Street, proceed straight north along the frontage road to Roosevelt Street. Turn left at Roosevelt Street (stay in far left lane which will take you straight west on Roosevelt St). Proceed west on Roosevelt Street to 63rd Avenue (there is a school on the north side) and turn left (south) and go about 4 blocks to the Stop sign at Fillmore St. Turn right and the house is 3rd house on the right.

You should see a Stude in the driveway (and next door) and the front yard has green grass surrounded by a wooden picket fence. The Studebaker feather will be out near the house. There will be a few driveway parking spots available for Studes, all other members can park along the left and right side of Fillmore Street.



What to expect when you are expecting your Travel ID in the mail


As you have heard by now, May 7 is the deadline for federal REAL ID, also known as the Arizona Travel ID, deadline. We know you are aware, because many of you are choosing to update your standard Arizona IDs to the federally compliant version. However, we also understand that many people may not know what to look for in the mail. You may expect an envelope with the MVD logo on it, or an envelope with a clear window showing your new ID. Sorry to let you down, but your new credential will come in a plain white envelope.

The Arizona Department of Transportation Motor Vehicle Division mails those new credentials to your home address in an unmarked envelope without an ADOT or MVD logo to protect your credential and your identity. Mail theft is a common way to steal identities, and that's another reason for MVD to be careful with your new driver license or ID card. As annoying as something that looks like junk mail can be, we'd rather have you face that than mail thieves.

Whether you went to an [MVD office](#) or an [authorized third party location](#) to update your ID, it should take about 10 days to arrive at your mailbox. So, if you are expecting a new card in the mail, you might just want to be a little more selective as you determine what to throw away. Avoid having to contact the MVD for another copy and possibly missing your flight without the new federally compliant ID card.
